Lisa REEFKE has been serving as Senior Political Affairs Officer with the United Nations Assistance Mission in Afghanistan (UNAMA) since February 2019. She started her career at the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) in Geneva, followed by assignments with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in Timor-Leste, as well as peace operations in Timor-Leste (*United Nations Office in Timor-Leste - UNOTIL*; and *United Nations Integrated Mission in Timor-Leste - UNMIT*); in Lebanon (*United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon - UNIFIL*); in Burundi (*Office of the Special Adviser to the Secretary-General on Conflict Prevention*); and in South Sudan (*United Nations Mission in South Sudan - UNMISS*). She also served with the Office of Operations in the Department of Peacekeeping Operations (DPKO) in New York.
